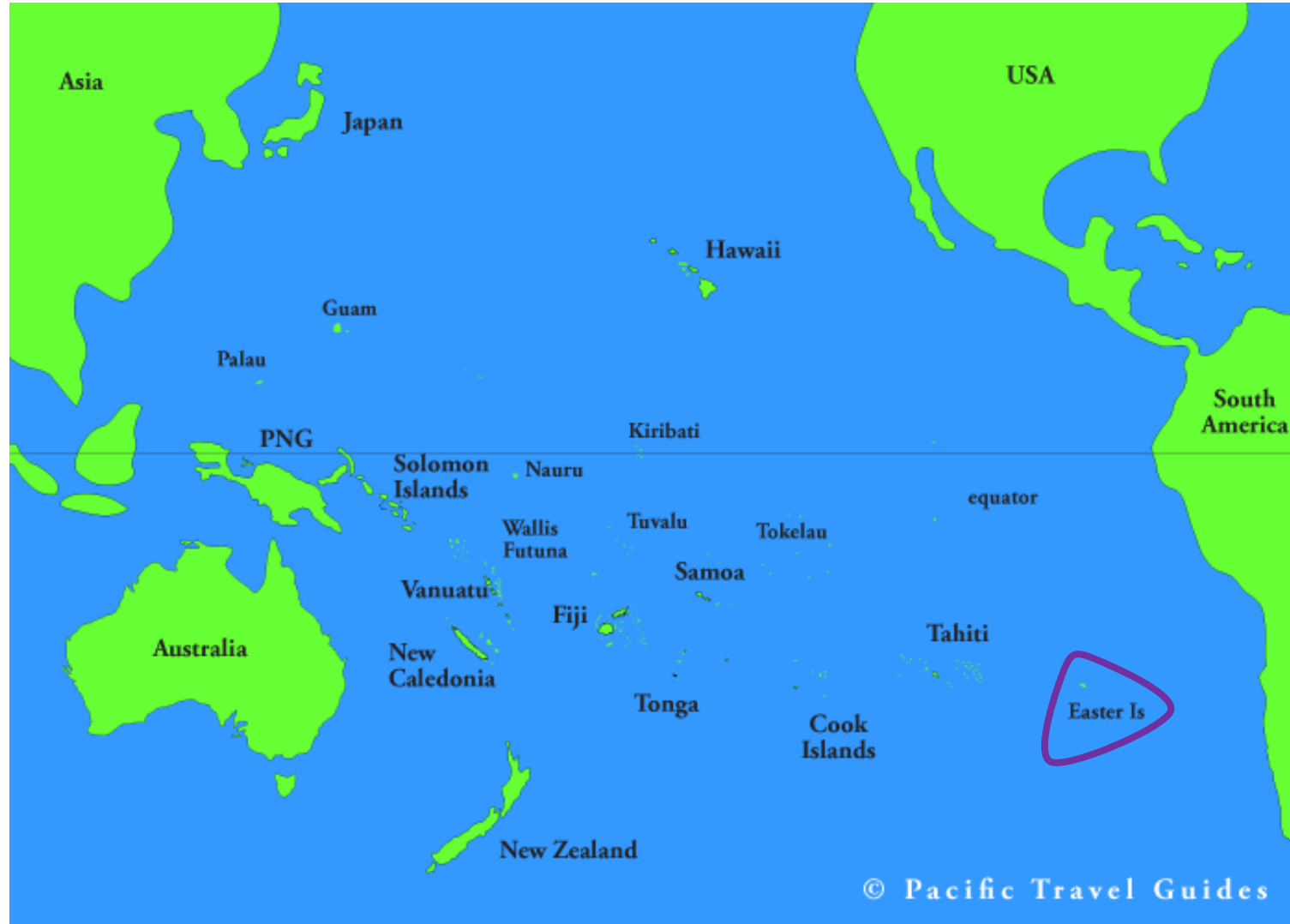

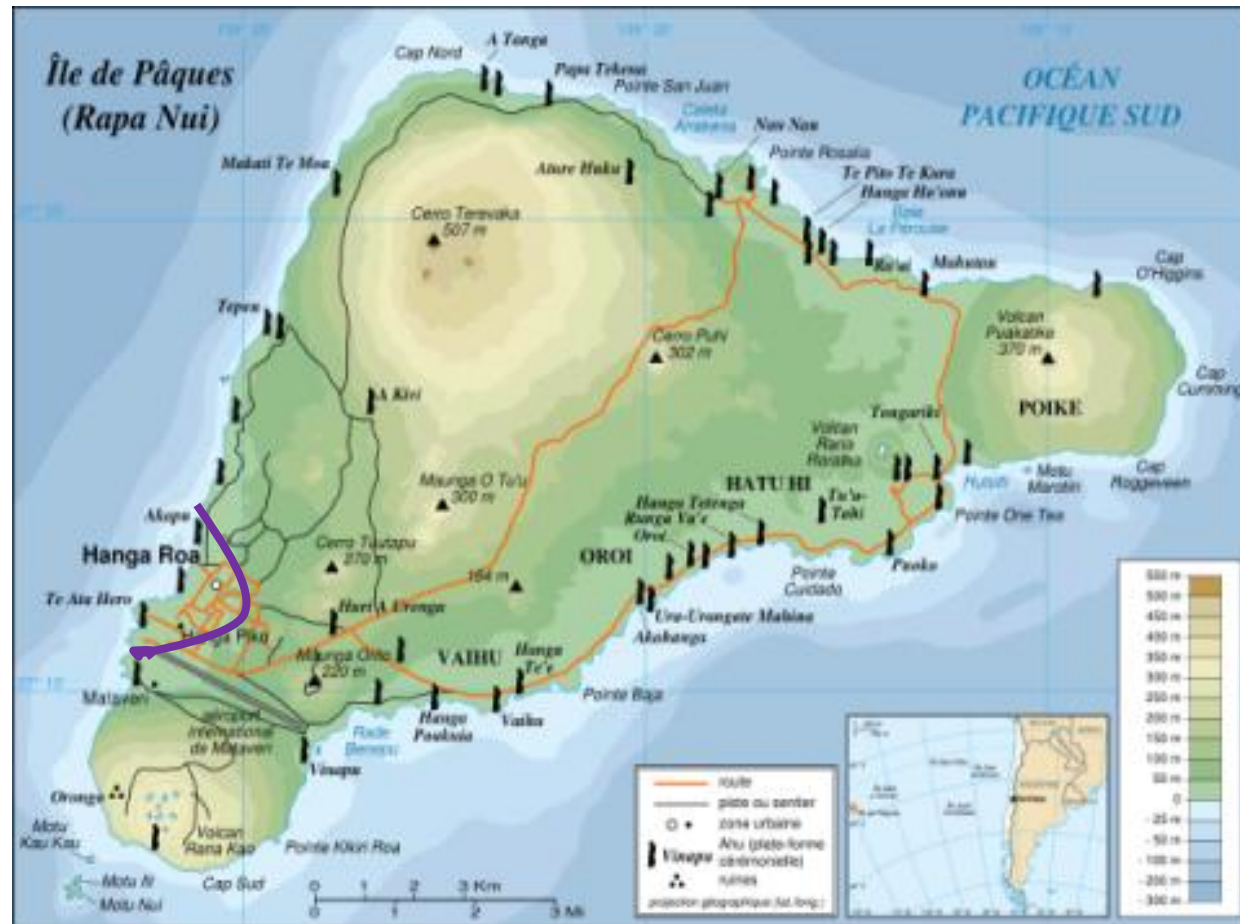

- Document analysis

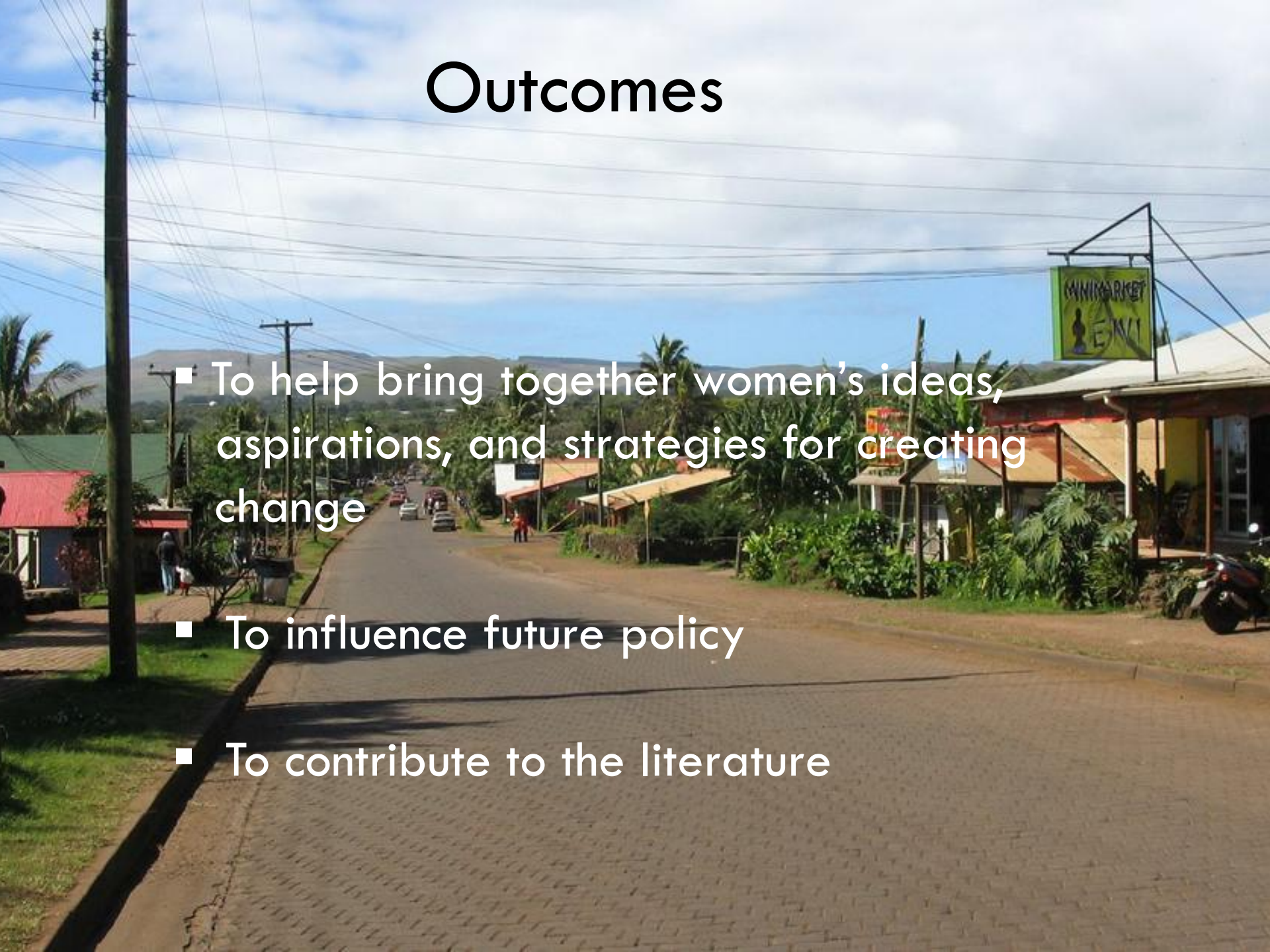
# 3 Main Parts to the Research

- 1) broad secondary research to explore the 'land question'
- 2) broad investigation of the land sovereignty movement – aspirations, techniques, etc.
- 3) in depth primary research exploring the role of women, their aspirations, and motivations for change

- To help bring together women's ideas, aspirations, and strategies for creating change
- To influence future policy
- To contribute to the literature
